



USP Compounding Compendium FAQs

1. What is included in the *USP Compounding Compendium*?

The *USP Compounding Compendium* features more than 40 USP Compounding General Chapters (including <795>, <797>, <800> and <825>) and more than 170 compounding monographs, along with General Notices and other key resources.

The [USP Compounding Compendium Table of Contents](#) provides a list of Compounding General Chapters and Monographs available. Please note, this list is subject to change and will be updated regularly.

2. What are the benefits of the online *USP Compounding Compendium*?

The *USP Compounding Compendium* is a new online format that will provide additional functionality to customers.

- Continuous online access to the most up-to-date published version of the Compounding Compendium.
- Compendial notifications to alert subscribers of newly released and/or updated content.
- Convenient accessibility from any digital workspace
- Enhanced search capabilities
- Customizable bookmarks and alerts

3. When did the new *Compounding Compendium* launch?

The *USP Compounding Compendium* launched on November 1, 2022 and is updated periodically to reflect new standards and monographs.

4. How do I find specific monographs or USP General Chapters in the *USP Compounding Compendium*?

Within the *USP Compounding Compendium*, you can search using the Menu; there is a search box at the top of the screen, and there are additional filter options for searching.

5. How do I access the online *USP Compounding Compendium*?

All users must have an Access Point account and register that account to the subscription key you receive after purchasing a subscription.

6. How do I create an account?

To create an Access Point account:

- Go to <https://register.usp.org>.
- Click on the "Create new Account" link at the bottom of that page.
- Fill-out the form and click SUBMIT.
- You will receive a validation email.
- Click on the link to validate your account.

NOTE: To register your new Access Point account to the subscription key for the *USP Compounding Compendium*, follow the instructions below:

- Go to the following website: <https://register.usp.org>.
- Login to this website with your Access Point credentials.
- After logging in, you will see a tab that says, "Paid resources". Click on this.
- On this next screen, you should see a box to enter your *USP Compounding Compendium* Subscription key. Enter it here and click on ADD.
 - (Cannot use copy and paste; must enter key manually.)
 - NOTE: You should have received a subscription key from either USP, when you purchased a subscription to the *USP Compounding Compendium*, or the purchaser within your organization.



- Once this is completed, log out of this website.
- Login back into the *USP Compounding Compendium* to start using the online platform.

7. Will the *Compounding Compendium* contain USP Chapters <795> and <797>?

The *USP Compounding Compendium* will feature the versions of USP General Chapters <795> and <797> that became official November 1, 2023, along with other relevant compounding standards and monographs.

8. If I have a *USP-NF* subscription, can I access the *Compounding Compendium* standards and content?

Yes, the *USP-NF* contains all USP monographs and general chapters including compounded monographs and chapters.

9. Am I able to download the compounding chapters from the Compounding pages of the USP website?

There is no option to download data from the new platform. However, there is an option to save the document as a PDF.

10. How long will a subscription to the *Compounding Compendium* last?

12-months.
